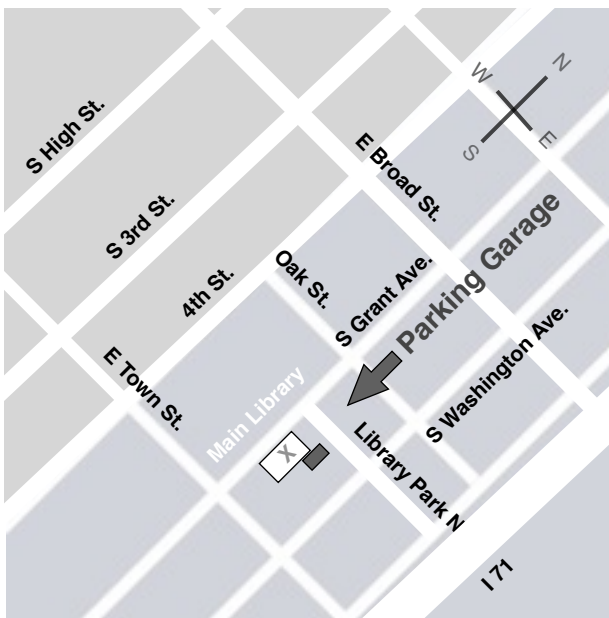
Library Parking

1. Each artist may submit 2-3.jpeg files of 2d and or 3d work made by the artist and is work created within the last year.
2. 2d works must be smaller than 4ft(h)x 30"(w). 3d work must be smaller than 32"(h) x 30"(w)x 30"(w) and will be presented on a pedestal.
3. Title each jpeg "lastname1.jpeg" ex:"ross1.jpeg, ross2.jpeg.
4. Each submission should be in jpeg format and no larger than 5"x7" 200ppi.
5. Complete full entry form and email artwork to **entry@gvartleague.com**.
6. Entry fee waived for 2010 German Village Art League Members. (GVAL membership \$20)
7. Entry fee for non-members. (\$10)
